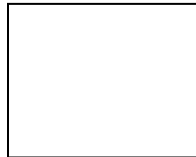

Eligibility: FVAC Fisher Gallery seeks innovative and imaginative artists working as sculptors. Original in-the-round and bas-relief work including 3-dimensional, bronze, ceramic, metals, glass, wood and mixed media executed during the last 3 years will be considered. Pieces should reflect the show title in some way.

Awards: *Fisher Award of Excellence* receives \$100 first place award, and two *Honorable Mention* awards receive \$50 gift certificate for art supplies. FVAC would like to thank our donors including Jerry's Artarama of CT.

Opening Reception: Saturday, July 12, 5 – 8:00 p.m. All entry artists are encouraged to attend.

Submissions & Delivery: Artists may submit digital files or slides for press purposes by June 10, 2008: actual work is to be delivered to FVAC Fisher Gallery, 25 Arts Center Lane, Avon, CT; Monday, June 30, & Tuesday, July 1, 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

Size limits: 3-dimensional pieces not to exceed 20"sq at base x 60"h, and not to exceed 100 lbs for pieces to be displayed on FVAC pedestals within gallery. Larger pieces may be considered with pedestals provided. Outdoor pieces have no limits aside from being weather resistant.

Return: Unsold work must be picked up on Sept 2, 9 – 3 p.m.

Requirements: Artists whose work is selected must meet the following requirements:

- Work must be available for sale, with a 40% commission payable to FVAC.
- By entering this exhibition the artist agrees to make information and images regarding the work available for publicity.

Fees: The only fee associated with submissions is 40% consignment commission payable to FVAC upon sale of artwork.

FVAC reserves the right to display or refuse work for any reason.

The Farmington Valley Arts Center (FVAC) was incorporated in 1974 as a not-for-profit organization. In the belief that artistic expression and creativity are vital to daily life, FVAC connects the community to the creative process through arts education for people of all ages, support and encouragement of working artists, and serving as a community resource for exposure of the arts. The Arts Center offers classes for adults and children, rents studio space, and operates a gallery featuring fine craft and fine art on display and for sale. It also conducts outreach programs with central Connecticut schools and social service agencies and offers an intensive summer arts camp. FVAC is a vibrant arts community that enables visitors to experience the entire creative process, from seeing artists at work to viewing finished creations in a gallery to learning the skills necessary to create works of their own.
